## Information Security Management




Regarding the ISMS (Information Security Management System) applied to the entire group of our company, we have obtained certification for ISO/IEC 27001:2022, an international certification system. We are continuously improving by operating the PDCA (Plan-Do-Check-Act) cycle with ISMS. In addition, with the guidance and advice from outside experts, we are further strengthening information security.

## Information Security Governance



The Executive Officer, CIO (Chief Information Security Officer) is responsible for the overall risk management and strategy formulation and implementation related to IT for the entire group, and reports directly to the President & CEO. As the supervisory function, the Board of Directors holds the ultimate supervisory responsibility as part of the overall governance of the management. Specifically, the response status to important risks, particularly regarding information security, is regularly reported through the Risk Management Committee.



Taking into account the size and region of each group entity, we have divided the ISMS into three regional divisions. Furthermore, by establishing a structure where the CISO (Chief Information Security Officer) oversees the ISMS for each region, we address region-specific situations while ensuring consistency across the entire group in the Information Security Management System.
